## Owyhee River

The Owyhee River is home to one of the most incredible brown trout fisheries in the lower 48 states. Fish average 15-17 inches, with fish over 20 inches common. The Owyhee is a year-round fishery with summer flows around 300cfs, while winter flows average 30cfs through this beautiful small canyon.

Trout rise readily to midges throughout the year. Spring fishing kicks off with the exciting Skwala stonefly hatch, followed by caddis, then PMDs. *Baetis* hatches occur spring through fall. When surface activity is absent, the large aggressive browns respond to streamers or nymph fishing.

The Owyhee River is a very special resource and we look forward to sharing it with you. It offers remarkable chances to catch 20+ inch trout on 4-5 weight fly rods.

Owyhee River Guided Fishing Trips are full-day trips with rates of \$450 for 1-2 anglers and \$675 for 3 anglers. We provide lunch and beverages. Booking days are limited, so be sure to reserve your Owyhee River fishing trip now for 2008!



## Boise River

### Walk-and-Wade or Float Trips

Join the *Idaho Angler* in discovering the Boise River's surprising fishery right in the middle of Idaho's Capital City! It's one of the best kept fishing secrets in southern Idaho. It fishes all year round, but is best when river flows are down, usually from July through April.

Fishing can be exciting for wild rainbows, browns, whitefish. Trout average 10–16 inches but, many rainbows and browns are caught each season that exceed 20 inches. Caddis and blue-winged olives hatch all summer, providing great dry fly action in the morning and evening hours. Nymphing with weighted flies and strike indicators is often productive in the deeper runs and slots. Steelhead are stocked into the river in late fall and fishing can be great.

Join our experienced guides for walk-and-wade fishing or spend a full-day with us on a Boise River float trip. You'll be surprised by the quality of fishing and the solitude you'll experience on a float trip.



## Snake River

### Flats fishing for Smallmouth and Largemouth Bass, and Carp

Southern Idaho boasts two other exciting fisheries that are not well known. The Snake River runs through southern Idaho and offers amazing flyfishing for **smallmouth** and **largemouth bass**, and **carp**.

**Bass Fishing** — Bass are a tremendous game fish on fly rod. *Idaho Angler* can teach you how to catch smallmouth bass along the Snake River shorelines or largemouth bass in nearby Lake Lowell or CJ Strike Reservoir on the Snake River.

**Flats fishing for Carp** — Many consider carp the bonefish of the desert west. The fish are spooky, large, and forage in schools along nearshore flats, where they are accessible to the wading angler. Runs are long and will take you well into your backing. Fishing is done by stalking the flats looking for tailing fish.
